

Inclusion/Exclusion Criteria, Screening Phase: <u>PCC: Population, concept, context</u> (JBI - more info <u>here</u>)

INCLUSION

Population	Children & Youth ages 5-24 ■ Reference pt: WHO
Concept	MHL interventions Any interventions addressing one or more pillars of MHL: Education and/or training about obtaining/maintaining positive MH Knowledge about MH, disorders, and/or treatment Levels/reduction of stigma about mental disorders Help-seeking attitudes, behaviors, efficacy Any quantitative study designs with/without control groups Grey-lit may include any source that addresses MHL interventions or those that address one or more of the MHL pillars
Context	 Administered in-Canada, or protocol developed and/or validated in Canada - but administered elsewhere Interventions developed and validated outside of Canada, but administered within Canada English or French language No limit to publication year

EXCLUSION:

- Ages ages 0-4 & ages 25-onward
- Interventions both developed and administered outside of Canada
- Therapeutic and clinical interventions, including formalized psychoeducation
- Protocols, proposed interventions, methodological papers, or reviews
- Quantitative studies such as epidemiological studies or cross-sectional surveys that don't measure the impact of MHL interventions
